

## Zoom Online Lesson (student interface)

### General explanation

ZOOM is a system that enables synchronized learning via Moodle. ZOOM simulates a virtual classroom that students and lecturers can utilize from the comfort of their own homes. ZOOM allows students to:

- View a live class
- "Raising your hand" online
- Chat participation
- Viewing shared documents
- Utilizing audio/video as set by the lecturer.

zoom can be operated within the following web browsers: Chrome, Edge, Firefox, Safari

### Connecting to ZOOM

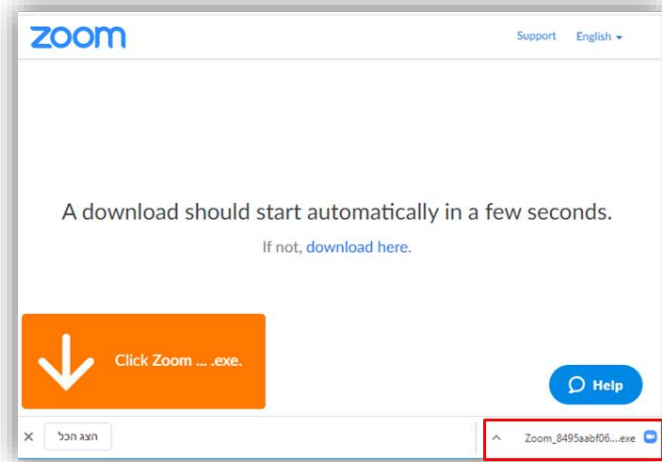
In order to view a zoom-based lesson, connect to Moodle and enter your course.

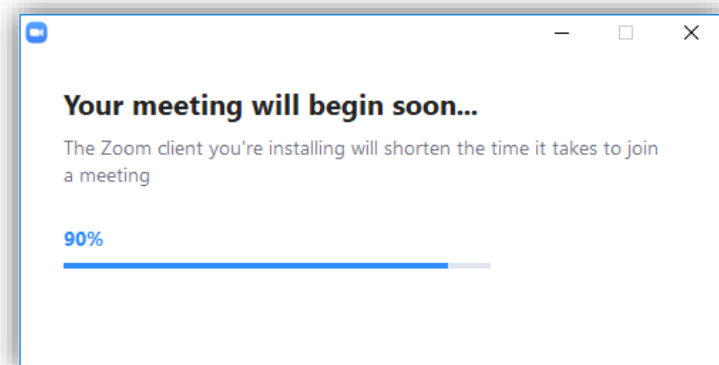


## **FIRST TIME OPERATION:**

you'll need to install zoom to your device by clicking on the zoom file in the bottom screen




You will receive an indication that **the meeting will begin soon**




Join Meeting
